Looks like the house at 88 Cowpens Way in San Mateo Highlands is finished, since it's now on the market.

Toward the end of construction of the house, Chamberlain Group / NexGen Builders paved Cowpens Way and extended the asphalt paving to create the driveway for the house.

During the paving process, they created a big mess at the intersection of Cowpens Way and New Brunswick Drive, along New Brunswick Drive, and at the intersection of New Brunswick Drive and Hoods Point Way.

Representing the residents of New Brunswick Drive, I request that Chamberlain Group / NexGen Builders clean up the globs of black asphalt on the street, the black tire tracks and tire marks up and down the street, and the black tar smeared on the sidewalk.

It's not fair that 88 Cowpens Way enjoys a freshly paved street at the expense of all the neighbors on New Brunswick Drive.
